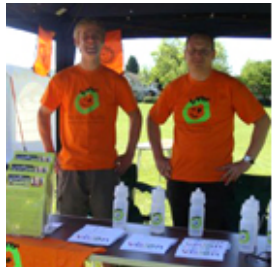


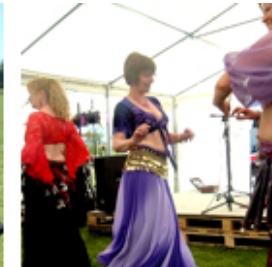
Vision Fest 2009
